




## STRAHMAN LINE BLINDS



Modern line blind

A line blind is a safety device designed for **positive shut-off of piping, equipment, or storage tanks** where positive shut-off is defined as a device in a closed, drop tight, verifiable, and maintainable position. This definition negates valves as they can have leak-by or use system pressure to stay closed. The positive shut-off feature makes line blinds perfectly attuned for permanent or long-term piping or tank isolation. Additionally, line blinds offer substantial benefits in saving time, equipment, and labor costs over traditional spectacle blinds. They also provide the security and safety an isolation valve cannot. Line blinds are a safety device, not a valve, and should only be used after a system has been drained and no longer under pressure.

### Line Blind Types

Line blinds come in two distinct varieties - spreading and non-spreading - both having their advantages depending on the application. The **spreading type (700 series)**, as its name implies, spreads the adjacent pipe flanges apart to allow for the spectacle plate to seal the upstream pipe. The advantage of this type is **cost-effectiveness**. This type also requires no tooling to operate. The spreading type is most at home in high pressure/extreme temperature applications.

The **non-spreading type (740 and 760 series)** uses a Cam system to create space between the body flanges allowing the spectacle plate to rotate or slide into position. The non-spreading type's major advantages are the design doesn't create any **undue pipe stress**, allow for pipe misalignment or make the pipe sag while the line is in the process of being shutdown.

### Quick Ship Program

- Viton, EPDM, or FEP seals
- Carbon steel or stainless steel bodies
